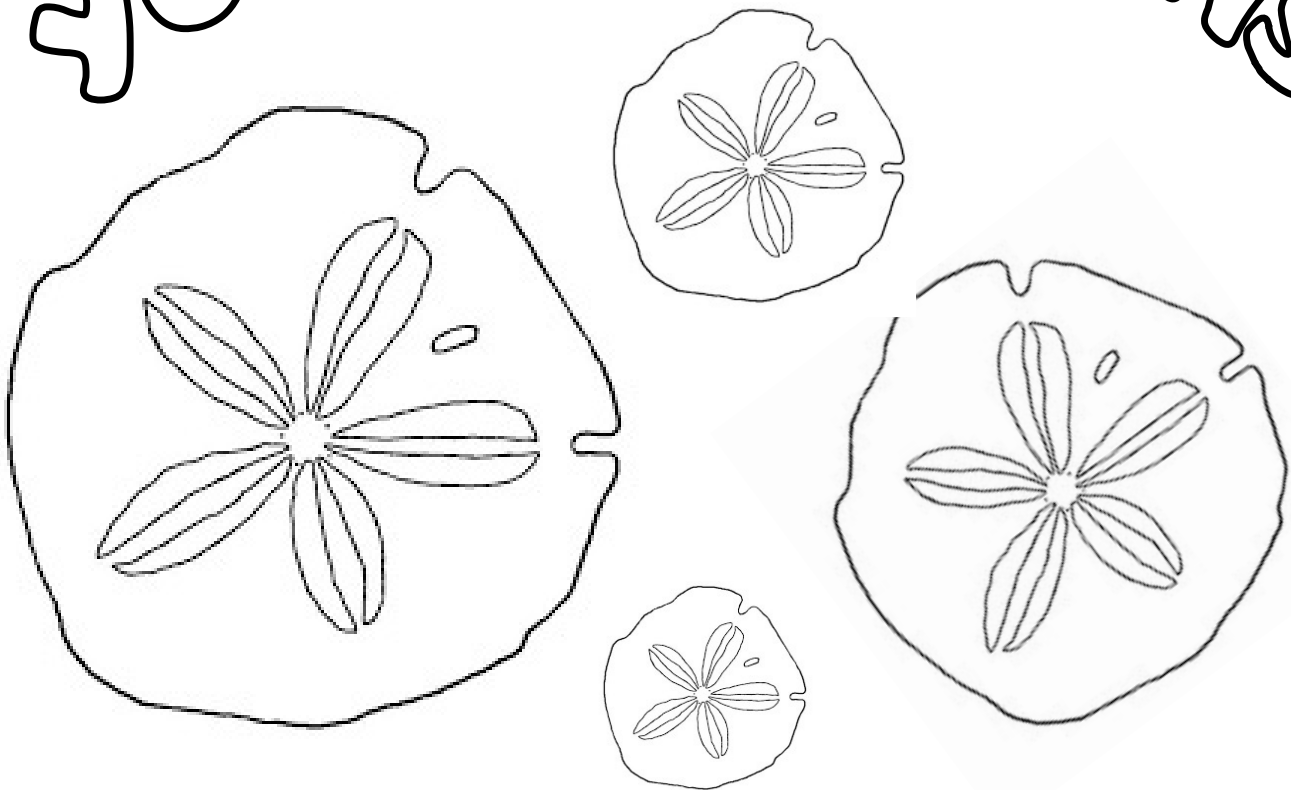


THE COLOR OF YOUR EMOTIONS



A "sand dollar" is a type of flattened sea urchin usually found on sandy seabeds. These animals have a round, flat skeleton that resembles a coin, hence the name "sand dollar." Sand dollars can range from a dark brown to red when alive. After the animal dies, exposure to the sun causes its color to fade and its skeleton eventually turns silvery white, highlighting its natural beauty.

Legend has it that finding the complete remains of the "sand dollars" will bring great wealth in peace, love and unity to whoever finds it.
